

Republic Services Trash and Recycle: If you have any questions about our trash or recycle service provided every Friday, **please contact Eugene Panrudkevich at wasteremoval@smrhoa.com** Concerns regarding our service should be reported to him immediately so that he can follow up with the company. A few reminders about our service:

Curbside service is 0 feet from the curb, or the edge of the street if no curb exists.

Your barrels **must be out by 6:00 a.m. to avoid being missed.**

Do not pack the container too tightly.

Refuse must be level with the top of the barrel, not overflowing.

Home compacted garbage needs to be in plastic bags and placed inside the barrel.

Drivers will not leave their trucks, so **please don't place items outside your barrel.**

Acceptable Recyclable Items:

Paper (white/colored)

Paperboard / Chipboard (like cereal or stationary boxes) with the exception of paperboard with metallic and wax coating

Phone books / Newspaper / Brown bags

Fiberboard (like paper egg cartons and some packing materials)

Milk / Juice cartons

Corrugated cardboard (flatten and cut as needed to fit in container)

#1 and #2 plastic bottles, jugs with necks or screw-on lids (no tubs, pails)

Steel / tin cans (including non-aerosol cans)

Glass food and beverage containers

Aluminum cans

Materials need to be clean, empty and dry and have no food or beverage residue. Throw very dirty items in the garbage. Leave labels on. Bottle caps can be recycled on or off. Put items in container individually, not inside of boxes, etc.

Unacceptable Items for Recycling:

Plastic Bags

Yard / Landscape debris

Wide-mouthed plastic containers, tubs / buckets / pails

Paper plates / cups / towels, napkins, tissue paper

Styrofoam / Packing peanuts

Aluminum foil / Pie plates

Hazardous items, medical supplies, electronics or batteries

Observed Holidays: Trash and recycling will be delayed one day for the following holidays unless we are notified otherwise. Barrels must be out by 6:00 a.m. on Saturday of these holiday weeks.
