

## **Sunrise Mountain Ridge HOA Fire Hydrant Information**

All our homes are well within 1,000 feet of a fire hydrant, as required by our zoning and enabled by Tucson Water in most north-side neighborhoods. We do conform to International Standards (ISO) Class 5 for fire protection and insurance purposes. This info is verified by the Business Office of Rural Metro.

We have eleven [11] hydrants in the neighborhood, and they are all well known and tested at intervals by the Operations folks of Rural Metro Fire District.

4071 - northerly portion of lot

4281 - southern boundary of lot

Placita del Tío;

4525 - norther corner of lot

Plaza de Toros;

4497 - across the street on common area

Trocha Alegre;

4517 - immediately adjacent common area

Via Colorada;

6880 - immediately adjacent driveway,  
near Sendero Chico

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
